ASSISTANT PROFESSOR OF FAMILY STUDIES

The Department of Family Studies and Social Work at Miami University invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor position on its Hamilton Campus in Hamilton, Ohio. A doctorate in family studies or related area (by date of employment) is required. College teaching experience is desired.

The successful applicant will be expected to teach undergraduate courses, including research methods, as well as seminars in the Integrative Studies program, participate in university service and civic engagement, and establish and maintain an active program of scholarly activity. The specific area of scholarly activity is open, although preference will be given to candidates with interests that complement expertise within the department or on the Hamilton Campus.

The Hamilton Campus is an open admission commuter campus with about 3500 students, located 16 miles from the main campus in Oxford, Ohio. Hamilton Campus Family Studies faculty are full members of the Department of Family Studies and Social Work. The Department of Family Studies and Social work also provides extensive service course work for students in many other majors within the social science and liberal arts programs at Miami University.

This position begins August, 2012.
