Teaching specialization and experience highly desired in Ethnic Studies 101 (Introduction to Ethnic Studies) and Ethnic Studies 201 (Inventing Ethnic America) and other core courses in our general education offerings. An MA in Ethnic Studies or closely related field is required.
